Develop a Financial Plan

- ▶ Know your options:
 - ▶ Grants, loans, work study, scholarships etc.
- ▶ In October of your senior year, you should begin filling out the FAFSA application. This is important even if you do not believe you will qualify. Some schools require FAFSA in order to award you any scholarship or grant
- ▶ CSS Profile: verify if your school requires this additional financial aid application. This is the one financial aid application that you pay for and you will usually apply during the first semester.
